New amenities allow the facility to maximize sporting events as a U.S. Paralympics Sport Club. A regulation sports court, resistance therapy pool, accessible rooftop terrace, indoor track, adaptive rock-climbing wall, multipurpose spaces, and outdoor sports and therapy spaces allow expanded and enhanced on-site services, including services to physically challenged children and youth.
