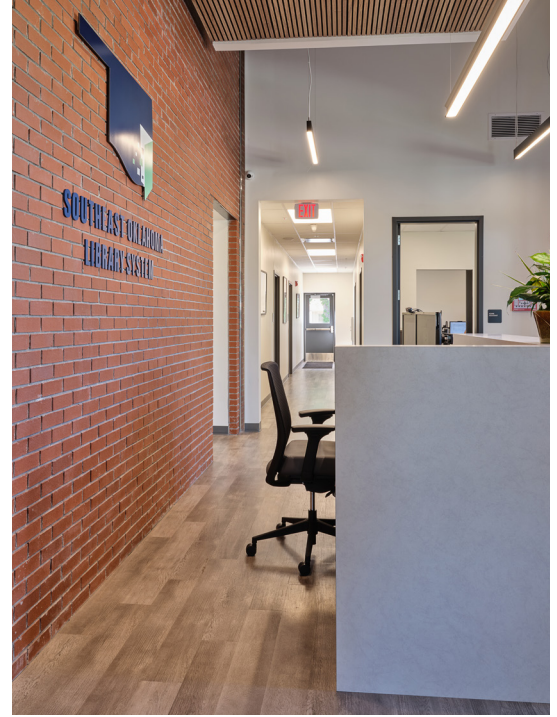




SOUTHEAST OKLAHOMA LIBRARY SYSTEM (SEOLS), CENTRAL SERVICES BUILDING

Ethos Architects has been working with the Southeast Oklahoma Library System (SEOLS) over the past few years to evaluate and plan several facilities in their system. The first facility to be under construction is SEOLS' new 6,500 SF Central Services Building. This building houses the System's executive director, human resources, the marketing and outreach services staff, as well as the Technical Services Librarian who is responsible for logging all new resources into the library's catalog system. In addition to the offices and workrooms, the building will also include a garage for the library's fleet of vehicles, and shipping and receiving of circulation materials. Located in the heart of McAlester, on Main Street, it was important to the staff that this facility help anchor the north end of Downtown and act as a resource for this growing community.
