





LAFORTUNE CLUBHOUSE

This project began as a renovation and addition to a 1950s golf course clubhouse and grill. Ethos determined that constructing a new clubhouse would be more cost effective than working within the limits of the existing structures to achieve the client's goals. The new clubhouse features a large entry, now visible from the street, that gives the clubhouse a presence and allows the pro-shop, large dining room and grill to operate independently. The finished floor is elevated three feet, providing panoramic views of the golf course. Timeless, natural, durable materials and neutral colors complement the finely-manicured golf course and landscaping of the park. Ethos developed a phasing plan to allow continuous operation of the golf course and park facilities during construction.
