The Hardesty Center will provide the space and resources for OSU faculty to perform leading-edge clinical neuroscience research across the lifespan, from newborns throughout adulthood, with a particular focus on the neurobiology and treatment of substance abuse and addiction. All of this is made possible through the Center's exceptional scientific infrastructure, including facilities for blood-based biomarker studies, and the most advanced research-grade 3T MRI in Oklahoma.
