



CHURCH OF SAINT BENEDICT ADORATION CHAPEL

Ethos designed this 1000 SF new chapel, the surrounding site improvements, and an interior remodel of the existing chapel to enlarge the confessionals and sacristy. Before construction, Ethos's Civil Engineering department designed extensive site work to resolve soil and drainage issues. Between the chapel and the existing building, a courtyard, garden, and contemplative green space sets the tone for the campus.

Ethos worked with the committee to achieve the desired look while helping the church stay in its budget. The project features refurbished antique stained-glass windows from a former Broken Arrow convent, arched ceilings, extensive wood millwork, and traditional ecclesiastical light fixtures. Ethos also provided coordination for installation of statues, refurbished antique altars, commemorative pavers, and the stained glass.
