Ethos worked with Tulsa Public Schools to design Oklahoma's first public Montessori school. The plan features flexible classrooms which open to pods, providing opportunities for collaboration and multi-age cross-disciplinary learning. The six-classroom expansion and complete interior remodel create light-filled learning spaces and larger and more varied learning spaces. Design elements are flexible, cheerful, and fun while keeping with the Montessori natural aesthetic. Varied learning areas are provided in the media center in the form of reading nooks, platforms, and flexible seating. By creatively remodeling the existing space and strategically building additional square footage, Ethos was able to transform this 1976 open-concept school and provide a new pre-K wing, update kitchen facilities, and build a dual-purpose FEMA-rated safe room and auditorium, all while designing for the new teaching and learning style of the school.
